From the Market

Abergavenny Market is excited to welcome back customers as trading resumes. We have taken a number of measures to ensure the safety of our customers, traders and premises staff that include;

- A new layout with a one way system that accommodates the 2 metre distance requirements
- Additional hand sanitiser and wash hand facilities for customers
- Access will be via the rear doors with a queuing system in place to control numbers within the hall

What is being implemented to give you the confidence to return to the high street

- Social distancing signage is in place throughout the town.

Street widening has been

- implemented on Cross Street and Market Street which restricts access to some on-street parking between 10am and 4pm Monday to Saturday.
- 20mph speed limit in many streets around the town centre
- Shops have available hand sanitiser, screens and are restricting the numbers permitted in shops
- Shops are implementing a queuing system

What's Open & Operating

- The Borough Theatre is unlikely to be operating until the New Year. Shows for 2021 will be going on sale through the website as they are confirmed and the Box office will open during the autumn. In the meantime work is going on behind the scenes to move forward with the building improvements.
- The Leisure Centre will be open when Welsh Government allows .
- The Castle Grounds are open but there is no date for the opening of the Museum .
- The Library is not likely to open until after the relocation to the Town Hall.
- The One Stop Shop will reopen following completion of the building works at the Town Hall. Monmouthshire County Council can be contacted on **01633 644644** or contact@monmouthshire.gov.uk. Recycling bags are available at supermarkets and convenience stores.
- The Car Parks are open and charges apply. One hour free parking and extra disabled parking bays will be provided temporarily at Tiverton Place car park.
- The public toilets at the Bus Station, Brewery Yard and Castle Street are open. Whitehorse Lane remains closed. Hand sanitiser units are in place as the existing combined hand washing and drying facilities are not available.
- The Dog Waste Bin weekly emptying service is operating normally
- The Litter Bin emptying service is operating normally.
- Bailey Park & Linda Vista Gardens are open.
- The Household Waste Site, Llanfoist is open by appointment only.
- The Market is open with a one way system and access by the rear doors.



What Shops Are Open?

The majority of the shops in the town centre are open and more are opening everyday. In addition, some shops are also offering click and collect, deliveries and appointments as shop owners understand that some customers will find these ways of shopping more suitable.
