a. Briefly tells us about the activities that your organisation/group undertakes

The Trust manages Abergavenny Community Centre where it organises a range of activities for different groups as well as providing meeting facilities for a range of community groups and public sector organisations needing a community venue. The Trust runs a parent and toddler group called Community Kids and has hosted other children's activities including Ti a Fi and Rugby Tots. Indoor activities have been very limited in the past 12 months due to Covid, however Action for Children have recently re-started their regular after school activities. During the summer holidays we held a very successful series of outdoor play sessions for small groups of parents and children observing the social distancing rules in force at the time. Feedback from parents demonstrated strong demand for these activities to be repeated when possible. [Please see the report attached with this application]

b. Please give more detail on how your project will meet the objective you selected above.

The lockdowns associated with the Covid pandemic have denied children the usual opportunities for socialising with their peers, so essential for their development, and for learning. Parents/carers have also missed out on contact with others that they

would normally have at parent & toddler groups or at the school gate. The intensity of lockdown where many parents will have been trying to work from home at the same time as supporting home schooling will have put a lot of pressure on the relationships within families. Our project provides opportunities during the Easter school holidays for children and their parents/carers to meet together for creative learning through play in the stimulating environment of the grounds of Abergavenny Community Centre. Skilled play workers/experienced forest school practitioners will run sessions that make the most of the natural resources at the Centre. Young children who have lacked contact with others will have the chance to rediscover the joy of playing with others in a Covid secure & safe environment. The feedback from parents from the sessions held last summer suggests that the experience will be very beneficial for the wellbeing of both children and adults. Parents involved before also noted how they had learned new play activities from the workers that they had been able to replicate at home.

f. Please specify how you will use the Town Council grant?

The grant will pay for two highly skilled & experienced play workers and materials for sixteen half-day sessions, and for the additional cleaning costs required to maintain a Covid secure environment.

The grant will be used to meet costs in the second week which falls into the Council's new financial year.

g. How will your project benefit the community of Abergavenny?

After a period where households have had little choice but to turn in on themselves, these activities will benefit the community by providing an opportunity for neighbours to reconnect and for children to develop again in the company of their peers. After a time of externally imposed limitations on freedoms & opportunities for creativity, it will be a chance for people to feel part of the community again.

Since the summer series we have begun talking with parents who may be interested in taking a leadership role in terms of planning further activities for children, with a view to fundraising for activities during the summer.
