The Town Clerk would be required to provide the local co-ordination and be the point of contact.</p> <p>Resolved to work with GAVO and MCC to manage a Town Ambassador Programme in Abergavenny and that the Town Council will fund the cost of providing clothing and equipment for the volunteers.</p>

16/20	<p>Approve a way forward on tackling the excessive pigeon feeding at Gabb Square, Baker Street, Abergavenny</p> <p>Councillors considered a report setting out the local impact of excessive feeding of pigeons at Gabb Square. Councillors appreciated that this has become a sensitive issue but the significant number of pigeons in this area was having a detrimental impact. The report proposed that ATC supports MCC with permitting the use of its crest on notices, joint press release and letter to residents.</p> <p>Resolved unanimously to support MCC in their action to tackle this issue.</p>
17/20	<p>Approve a new budget for publicity</p> <p>Resolved unanimously to set up a new budget for publicity and to view £2000 from events budget into the new publicity budget</p>
