Councillors received an informative presentation from Mal Edgson showing that in the 12 months until 31st May 2021, 227 clients from Abergavenny wards were helped with 300 cases and 754 issues. There is suppressed demand on issues such as debt advice due to the protections imposed during the pandemic. Citizens Advice expect demand on their services to increase significantly once the protections are lifted. They are seeking funding for a new financial inclusion project to fund a project worker for 12 months working across Monmouthshire. A grant has already been received from the Moondance Foundation. Mal thanked the Town Council for their ongoing financial support. Councillors requested individual ward data and a copy of the presentation. Cllr Groucutt who is on the MCC Tackling Poverty & Inclusion group will contact Citizens Advice to arrange for them to address this group to seek additional financial support from MCC. Cllr Groucutt also thanked Citizens Advice for continuing to operate a satellite service at ACE. Citizens Advice is also looking for new volunteers.
