TOWN CLERK UPDATE

1. E 117/22 A report has now been received from KAT regarding the 6 month review of the interventions they presented to ATC at the November meeting (appendix A). It is still their desire to engage in another stakeholder meeting in January 2023 with our assistance with MCC, Gwent Police, KWT, to look at lessons learned and establish areas in the town which require further interventions.
2. E 119/22: A core group of volunteers have established a steering group and communications so far have been promising. FotE, ATT and Abergavenny Climate Action are keen to drive this idea forward. Plans are in place to visit Monmouth Climate Action Group as they have already had great success in their engagement with the community on the climate emergency. Initial conversations with MCC didn't yield a desire to get involved at this stage but they are happy to advise and signpost where needed. The group have been discussing the programme name, the organisation roles and other key points, including whether an environment fair is indeed the right thing to hold, or if something else may be more beneficial. The momentum so far has been heartening, those already engaged with the steering group are keen to ensure whatever kind of event is decided upon that it will be a worthwhile engagement activity for the wider community to ensure the aims of the event are achieved. ATC still need to provide another point of contact for this to assist Cllr Barnes, so if anyone would like to assist and get involved, please contact the Town Clerk so introductions to the steering group can be made.
