1. ABERGAVENNY IN BLOOM

2. CCTV WALK AROUND 22<sup>ND</sup> MAY 2023 4:30PM

In conjunction with MCC ASB officers John Crandon and Andrew Mason, a walk around has been booked for all Councillors (both Town and County) to attend. This will be a walking meeting. If Councillors have particular hot spot areas they'd like to visit, or to discuss if we are unable to visit them on foot, please email these in advance to the Town Clerk to submit to both MCC officers and Gwent Police Officers who will be attending. This will be to discuss ASB issues, CCTV coverage and ongoing maintenance, plus any other issues.

3. PAVILION – BAILEY PARK

Exterior works to the pavilion have been completed to make it safe for users. Some interior works will be carried out this year but not had any details at this point.

4. SENIOR CITIZENS HALL – FAIRFIELD CAR PARK

Demolition works will commence to remove the former Senior Citizens Hall on Fairfield Car Park. The site will remain vacant once the removal is complete.
