The draft MCC report was discussed which included proposed changes to the terms of an asset transfer agreement. The sliding scale of compensation for investment was not considered acceptable and did not make an asset transfer any more attractive. The status quo whereby the Town Council contributes to the maintenance and cleaning and ownership remains with MCC is preferred way forward

The proposed closure of White Horse Lane toilets is a MCC decision

The proposal for the Town Council to open discussions on a community toilet scheme with businesses in Frogmore Street area that have toilets was welcomed.
