Independent Review of Community & Town Councils

Prior to the formal meeting, Kathryn Silk, Member of the Panel undertaking an Independent Review of Community & Town Councils addressed the Council. The Panel was set up in October and expect that the review will take 12 months.

Four questions are being posed:

- What should Community & Town Councils be responsible for?
- How should they operate?
- What's standing in their way to deliver for the local community?
- How do Councils ensure they best represent their community?

Views on these four questions to be sent to Welsh Government by end of February 2018.

The review was generally welcomed as it provides a good opportunity to look at future arrangements. The review should consider whether there should be more powers at a local level. Ongoing issues around boundaries and levels of precept and ability of Town & Community Councils to raise money through other means than the precept.
